

Table 2. Child increases to unemployment benefits to be discontinued

<p>Mikko has sporadic employment. He is a single parent with two children.</p>	Income:
	Receives a wage of 720 euros during the adjustment period for the labour market subsidy.
	<i>Mikko's labour market subsidy before 1 April 2024:</i>
	When adjusting the labour market subsidy, the amount of Mikko's wage that exceeds the exempt amount of 300 euros is taken into account, that is 420 euros.
	Each euro of earned income above the exempt amount decreases the labour market subsidy by 50 cents.
	Mikko receives a child increase to the labour market subsidy for two children to a total amount of 184 euros per month.
	Mikko receives adjusted labour market subsidy of 774 euros per month.
	<i>Mikko's labour market subsidy after 1 April 2024:</i>
	When adjusting the labour market subsidy, the full amount of Mikko's wage is taken into account, that is 720 euros.
	Each euro of earned income decreases the labour market subsidy by 50 cents.
Child increases will not be paid to the labour market subsidy after 1 April 2024.	
Mikko receives adjusted labour market subsidy of 440 euros per month.
